Proposed Zoning By-Law Amendments Pursuant to G.L. c. 40A, § 5 Relative to the Post Office Square Parking and Loading Standards

The Planning Board will hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, October 6, 2011 at 7:30 PM at the Sharon Town Hall, Lower Level Meeting Room, Sharon, Massachusetts, to review a proposed Amendment to the Zoning By-Laws to revise certain sections of the Zoning By-Laws affecting the so-called "Post Office Square" area, as summarized below:

Amend Sections 3110 and 3111 "Business A and C and Professional District Parking Requirements" and "Number of Parking Spaces Required" by exempting outdoor seating space and certain non-residential nonconforming uses from additional parking requirements and to allow the Planning Board or the Board of Appeals, as applicable, to review and make decisions on parking issues; to require bicycle parking in Business Districts A and B; and by adding parking requirements for non-residential uses in the Business District A.

Amend Section 3114 to add driveway width requirements.

Amend Section 3115 to amend requirements for off-street loading bays.

Amend Section 3117 relative to buffer screening.

Amend Section 3120 "Business B District Parking Requirements" by deleting it in its entirety.
